1) On hearing that a man, whom *he had previously dismissed and who had subsequently attempted to ruin his substantial business*, had returned with his family to the area and was in great destitution, Mr. Samuel Budgett, "The Successful Merchant" who lived in Kingswood, Bristol, nearly 200 years ago, went with a friend to visit his home.

"The house was in a miserable state, the garden was desolate, neither meat nor bread within the door, and two fine boys were lying in bed because they had no clothes". Mr Budgett immediately ordered meat from the butcher, bread from the baker, sent groceries, sent a tailor to clothe the children, hired a man to till the garden, and gave the family an allowance of 12 shillings a week for a very lengthened period, until this man, who lacked get-up-andgo, found work

We are the children of *an enormously extravagant God*, and sometimes we have the privilege of living that way




