-Mentoring and 1-2-1 support of some boys and girls who just need an extra bit of love and care.

-Supporting and being there for some chaotic families through their daily lives.

With love, Zoe & Suzie Zoe and Suzie live in the faith that God with provide for all the financial needs of ENOUGH, this means that they don't take a regular wage but that all financial gifts cover everything from rent to living costs to resources and anything in between. The work of **ENOUGH** cannot continue or develop without the commitment of people's sponsorship. We have been so blessed by those who have financially given to us over the last 8 years and God is continuously faithful in His provision. If you feel that you would like to financially support **ENOUGH**, we would be so excited and grateful; either as a one off or with an ongoing commitment.

For example:

>£5 per week would help us send 1 lively boy to trampolining. This enables him to have some quality 1-2-1 time and confidence building.

>£50 a month gives Suzie and Zoe the opportunity to do something fun for themselves!

>£70 one off payment gives us the opportunity to get up to 20 young people out of the community and exercise together whilst having fun with one another.

>£3 a day would cover our petrol, rushing from here to there to everywhere! Enabling us to be like 6th emergency to local families!

>£40 a week, feeds up to 18 young people who then stay to listen to how God can be a part of their lives.

>£36 covers the total cost of resources for 6 girls from one school, to complete the Transition confidence building course.

> \pm 20 a fortnight would cover our electric in the house which is where we do most clubs.

\$625 is the cost of our rent for 1 month, which has enabled us to live in the heart of the community for the last 8 years, and many more to come if you are able to give.
