The full series of Dunamis events covers:

- 1. Gateways to Empowered Ministry
- 2. In the Spirit's Power (Spiritual Gifts)
- 3. The Power of Prayer
- 4. The Healing Ministry of Jesus
- 5. Spiritual Warfare and Kingdom Advancement
- 6. Listening Evangelism

Each event is self-contained and immensely useful, though maximum benefit comes from taking part in all six. If you join a series partway through you are invited to "Catchup" to cover key material from the first event. Leadership for each series is drawn from previous participants as Dunamis continually raises up anointed leadership and does not depend upon a few "experts".

Dunamis leadership teams hold themselves accountable to the participants at each event. There is honesty and vulnerability about personal "successes" and "failures", a genuine desire that nobody be guilty of "manipulation", and a longing to cultivate mature discernment towards spiritual activity rather than naïve credulity or worldly scepticism.

Dunamis is run under the auspices of the Dunamis Fellowship, a ministry of PRMI (Presbyterian Reformed Ministries International) and in partnership with GEAR (Group for Evangelism and Renewal within the URC).

Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit would energise our faith, empower our service, and enable us to live like Him. He promised we would experience the dynamic power of God at work in ordinary lives. He put it like this

"You are witnesses of these things. I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high." Luke 24:48-49

The Dunamis Project is designed to help people experience and live in the reality of this promise. It is a training and equipping event.

Dunamis is run as an experimental 'workshop' environment with a focus on learning rather than on teaching. Each event is characterised by:

- Intercessory prayer cover, both on-site and off-site
- Anointed, Spirit-led worship
- Extensive systematic teaching from Scripture

- Discussion and prayer in small groups
- A flexible approach to the programme, constantly seeking guidance from the Holy Spirit

- Reflection thoughtful critique and evaluation of events and experiences, teaching the process of spiritual discernment
