## Sept 6th: BRAD HAWKES: Peer-led groups - releasing young people to lead

Brad Hawkes is National Leader of New Generation UK, the British branch of an international network with more than 20000 members in 20 nations, all working for a more positive school environment through peer-led Christian groups praying and reaching out schools and colleges.

## Nov 1st: GAVIN CALVER: Hope for a new generation

Gavin Calver is the National Director of Youth for Christ, a charity that works with over 300,000 young people a month in places such as schools, prisons and churches. A theology graduate, ordained evangelist and regular public speaker, his third book *Lazy, Anti-social & Selfish?* came out in 2009.

## Jan 10th: STEVE CLIFFORD: Unity - is it worth it?

Steve Clifford became General Director of Evangelical Alliance in April 2009. Steve's previous roles have included chairing Hope 08 and Soul Survivor, Soul in the City London and March for Jesus International. He has also been involved in church planting and running leadership and discipleship teams within the Pioneer network.

## Feb 28th: PATRICK REGAN: Reaching the unchurched

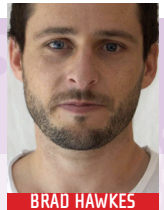

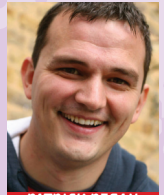
