What is HOPE BRISTOL 2018?

Over the last 17 years, The Noise in Bristol has grown from 30 volunteers to over 900 volunteers from local churches. It started because a few leaders were inspired by Message 2000 in Manchester and ‘caught a vision’ to see this reproduced in Bristol. Now is the time to give away to young people across the nation, what we have seen happen in the urban estates in Bristol and see what God is going to do with the next generation. At the same time, we continue to build the next stage of united action of churches in Bristol together to reach this city, especially its youth.

Things to consider

Will your event have any entertainment?

You could simply provide background music for your event, or invite a guest speaker or entertainment. Could someone in your church share a talent?

Will you be serving refreshments?

The type of event you run will dictate the kind of refreshments you provide, however it’s often a good idea to at least provide a cup of tea! Please note, we are unable to provide funding for refreshments or resources for your event and your church will be responsible for ensuring food hygiene requirements are met.

When will your event run?

Most Hope Bristol 2018 activities are being held in the afternoon, between 1pm and 5pm (including clear up time), so that volunteers are available to attend the morning worship and team gatherings. You will need to consider the availability of your volunteers and venue before making this decision.

Who can you invite and how?

This will be a great opportunity to invite new people to connect with your church. We will provide you with invitations, posters and advice on how to promote your event among in your community. In addition, we will promote your event centrally via our network of contacts across Bristol.

Where will your event be held?

You may hold your event at your church building, or you may choose to hire another local community venue instead. Please let us know so that we can publicise it correctly.

What about insurance?

Your church is responsible for organising the public liability insurance for your event. Please contact us if you need advice about this.
