Winter 18/19:

Last winter, churches in Bristol once again opened their doors as part of the Bristol Churches Winter Night Shelter (BCWNS) project. Adopting the Housing Justice model for church-based shelters, a significant contribution was made to homeless work in Bristol. The intention is to open up churches in the same way this winter for a 12-week period from January to March 2019.

The outcome is that we already have a complete set of venues in which to host this year's shelter! Volunteers:

The project was blessed with over 400 volunteers, representing over 60 churches, for last year's 12-week project. This was an amazing response to the need for homeless shelter in Bristol. We are ready to launch our volunteer sign up this year which allows volunteers to sign up for a training session in November. Finances:

Last year's project was significantly helped by the financial contributions which enabled costs to be met with a surplus of just over £2300. The provisional budget for 2018/19 amounts to £34,324 which allows for running costs and investment in the long term sustainability of the project.


