Dear BSC Friends



Prayer Spaces in Schools



In January we hosted another Prayer Spaces in Schools training event. It was fantastic to have about 20 people there, and to sense their excitement about running their first prayer space in their local school. It has been a joy to support a Bristol Secondary school and their local churches as they prepare to host their first reflective/prayer space. We have also been supporting a 6th form college in Bristol who hosted their first prayer space in early March.

Networking



We love networking and partnering with others across the city – Bristol Diocese, Together4Bristol, Müllers and others! In partnership with Christians in Science, we organised for speakers from The Faraday Institute in Cambridge to visit three schools in Bristol. They led some amazing sessions with both primary and secondary students focussing on the debate about how Science and faith work together. We have continued to liaise with Transforming Lives for Good with regards to the growth of their work in Bristol. We are also booked to run training events for Trinity College Ordinands, Bristol Baptist College students and for the Bristol Methodist Circuit.
